Warksburn Old Church offers a private, **Beyond Net Zero** environment which blends discreet luxury with a genuine commitment to sustainability.

This exclusive venue is the world's only **Passivhaus certified** church conversion, and winner of the Green Tourism **Gold Award** amongst many other accolades. It is one of the UK's most energy-efficient buildings, using only zero carbon electricity, and exporting more energy than it consumes.

Located 45 minutes from Newcastle-upon-Tyne and Carlisle, and only 30 minutes from Newcastle Airport, Warksburn Old Church provides an inspiring, zero carbon setting for **high-performance** teams to achieve strategic clarity.

A serene and inspiring working environment: an outstanding space for exceptional teams to think

Combining stunning architecture with an exceptionally calm interior, Warksburn Old Church is a unique space, designed for discretion, security and focus, ensuring zero distractions and maximum productivity for your senior team. A private garden and patio are also at your disposal.

Our **technology & connectivity** setup is C-Suite ready. Delegates benefit from a full Gigabit Fibre-to-the-Premises (FTTP) internet connection and a Gigabit mesh WiFi network within the property, guaranteeing speed and reliability across the entire property. A secure, single-touch QR code makes WiFi network access effortless.




Drive discussion and decision-making with **professional presentations** on our 55-inch 4K Ultra-HD OLED screen. The display is able to mirror any device on the secure, private WiFi network for immediate, seamless presentations. Furthermore, a hardwired ethernet connection ensures instantaneous, lag-free streaming of any internet-based content.

Capacity & Accommodation

The venue is suitable for intensive one-day meetings for up to 8 delegates. The statement ceramic and glass table provides the focal point for discussions; with the colours of its accompanying chairs echoing the tones of stained glass by the Victorian master Charles Eamer Kempe.

For longer C-Suite retreats, the property offers overnight accommodation in three individually designed bedrooms, each with a porcelain tiled luxury en-suite bathroom.



The layout is designed for maximum privacy, accommodating a maximum of three couples (six guests total) across three luxury suites. All three bedrooms feature a superking bed. Two of the bedrooms can be optionally configured in a twin bed layout.

Supplementary Accommodation

For groups exceeding the overnight accommodation capacity of the Church itself, additional delegates can usually be accommodated at a neighbouring, highly-regarded hotel and gastropub just 200 metres away, ensuring the entire team remains within easy walking distance.

Security

Electronically programmed doors ensure absolute privacy and access control. A unique, one-off access code is generated for every booking, which expires upon departure.

Client security requirements (both physical and cyber) can generally be accommodated.

Service, inclusions and options

Every booking includes an **inspirational sustainability briefing**. This takes the form of a short introduction to the property's history and its 'Beyond Net Zero', Passivhaus-certified performance. This resonates well with leadership teams committed to sustainable business practices and provides a unique talking point.



A particular highlight is the 'history comes full circle' story of the building's benefactor, Sir George Barclay Bruce (pictured here, portrait courtesy of Westminster College, Cambridge). Sir George was an eminent Victorian engineer who funded the church's original construction in 1875.

He began his career apprenticed to Robert Stephenson, whose 'Rocket' locomotive ignited the Industrial Revolution. When he became President of the Institution of Civil Engineers in 1887, Sir George's visionary Presidential Address contained the world's first documented reference to the renewable generation and storage of electricity – technologies now at the very heart of Warksburn Old Church.

Parking. Ample private parking with **free EV charging** is available for delegates' cars at zero cost. Delegates' cars will charge at 7kW/hour via a standard Type-2 connector. Four EV chargers are available on site.


